EMPLOYEES MUST WASH HANDS



- 1. After touching bare human body parts other than clean hands and clean exposed arms**
- 2. After using the toilet**
- 3. After coughing, sneezing, using a handkerchief or tissue, using tobacco eating or drinking**
- 4. After handling soiled equipment or utensils**
- 5. During food preparation, as often as necessary**
- 6. When switching between working with raw and ready-to-eat food**
- 7. Before donning gloves for working with food**

ALL EMPLOYEES SHALL WASH THEIR HANDS BEFORE LEAVING THE RESTROOM AND AGAIN UPON RE-ENTERING THE FOOD PREPARATION AREA

FOOD EMPLOYEES SHALL CLEAN THEIR HANDS AND EXPOSED PORTION OF THEIR ARMS IN A HANDWASHING SINK AND MAY NOT USE A FOOD PREPARATION OR WAREWASHING SINK.
